

How to Get Started:

- Determine whether your CPE event is targeted towards Pharmacists, Pharmacy Technicians, or both audiences.
- Decide if you're planning a single topic event to be presented on one day or if it will be a multiple topic event scheduled for several days.
- Review the Fee Schedule for associated event costs and contact the CPE Office with any questions.
- Complete the New Event Session Form (xlsx) as soon as you have program date(s) and a set agenda.
- Complete one of the Single Topic or Mutliple Topic Event Forms based on your intended target audience.
- Alongside your "New Session Form" and "Single or Multiple Topic Event Form", we will require additional documentation as stated in the section below.
- Once all forms are completed, please send them to the CPE Office by emailing them to HSC-Pharmacyce@salud.unm.edu.
- The CPE Office will review your application and confirm your acceptance.

Plan, Present, Sponsor (Continued)

Additional & Required Documentation

These items must be provided to the CPE office no less than 2 weeks before the event date. Presentation materials and final agenda are excluded to this timeline.

- Have ALL speakers and event coordinators complete a Signed Disclosure Statement.
- Provide current CVs for ALL speakers.
- Review the Advertisement Checklist and provide a copy of any draft advertisements already created. If an
 agenda/brochure or any other supporting documents have already been created, please include these with
 your submission for review.
- Email these supporting documents to the CPE Office at HSC-Pharmacyce@salud.unm.edu. If any
 documents are missing and/or you do not have them yet please include this in your email.
- If you have questions or need further support to complete any of the required documentation for your event, please contact the CPE Office.

Upon Event / Program Approval

- The CPE Office will create your Universal Activity Number(s) (UAN). This is an identification number assigned to each activity.
- The CPE Office will send you an email with instructions for distributing an event evaluation for attendees, along with any applicable invoices.
- Finally, a participant and evaluation summary report will be provided to the program coordinator after all
 evaluations have been completed.

How to Receive CPE Credit Hours for Attending an Event

In order to receive CPE credit for attending an event, an online evaluation is required by each participant.

If You Attended a CPE Live Event:

You must apply for credit online within 30 days after the event by completing a required online evaluation. The directions and access code for completing the evaluation will be provided by the CPE presenter in your program handouts or through an email after the event.

Follow These Steps:

- Visit the evaluation website link provided to you by your CPE presenter.
- You will want to create a user account by visiting this link https://unmpharmacyce.org/user/login and following the prompts under the "New Account Sign-Up" section.
- If you have an existing account, please sign in under "Current Account Holders". If you forgot your password you can reset it by clicking here.
- Once you are signed in, you will click on the "Complete Live Activity Evaluations" and find the name of your
 event in the drop-down menu in order to pull up the correct evaluation form.
- Have the access code that the CPE presenter provided you ready.
- · Have your NABP e-Profile Number (ePID#) ready.
- If you do not already have a NABP ePID account one can be created at the following website: [Obtain New Hyperlink] or you can visit the FAQ Page to learn more about NABP ePID#.
- · Complete the online course evaluation form and submit.
- Then you can verify the credit has been awarded by viewing your NABP e-profile account.
